The Robert R. Lee Idaho Promise Category A Scholarship

A luncheon highlight each year is recognizing one of the Robert R. Lee Promise Scholarship recipients. This state-sponsored scholarship is designed to encourage Idaho students to do well in school, graduate, and continue their education beyond secondary school at an Idaho college or university. The Scholarship provides up to \$3,000 per year, is renewable annually and is available for a limited number of qualified students pursuing either academic or professional-technical programs. To qualify for this scholarship, graduating Idaho resident students must have a cumulative high school grade point average (GPA) of at least a 3.00 or an ACT composite score of 20 or better.
